 - \$85.26 was withdrawn for bills to Piggly Wiggly, the County Line Road fire, and soda/water for the Brat Fry/Bake Sale. It was decided as a group to donate the food provided at the County Line Road Fire instead of paying for the gas used to run the fire truck at the Brat Fry since it would be close to equal out.

- Sunday Activities
 - Pig Roast – Brandi attempted to contact Jack from Montello that has helped with the campground Pig Roast. She has not heard back from Jack yet. Besides a pig roast, we would also serve baked potatoes, salads, and a non-breaded chicken.
 - Games – Abigail had a list of ideas for games including lawn twister, a jumping castle, a giant squishy sensory bag/blob, water games like fishing or a duck game, giant tic tac toe, balloon twister, a egg/balloon toss, or a possible comedian/balloon artist. Abigail has gotten in contact with face painter who will not charge us anything to book her, but will put up a sign saying that a certain percentage of her profits from that day will go to us.
 - Corn hole tournament – We are in need of ½ inch plywood (48x24) and several 2x4 for legs. We are hoping that the firefighters will help with building the game. Naomi is to contact someone to get a graphic wrap to cover the boards. Discussion was brought up

to raffle off the game at the end of the day. Naomi was looking into a canvas for the beanbags.
