 - We made \$886.25 in food.
 - We made \$235.75 in donations alone
- A check was donated written to the Princeton Fire Department for \$70. It was voted to donate the check to the Fire Department since that was the intention of the donor who wrote the check. Check was handed to Becky to give to an officer in the Fire Department.
- Our bill at Sherms will be taken care of for the beer, soda, and hot dog buns.
